### HOW ORIGINAL SIN IS TRANSMITTED TO US

[from *Catholic Apologetics*, by Bp. Sheehan, 1950]

Original sin is not transmitted to us through our soul, because our soul is directly created by God. It is transmitted to us through the bodily element, the flesh we have inherited from Adam. The moment he sinned, he lost his dominion over his bodily inclinations; his flesh was now in a state of rebellion against the spirit, craving for its own pleasures and gratifications, and it is that rebellious flesh which we have derived from him. Our soul did not exist before our conception. It sprang into existence only in the precise instant of its union with the contaminated bodily element. The entire living man, soul and body, produced by that union was therefore from the very first in a condition not intended by God. We may compare His action in creating our soul to the night-atmosphere which causes dew drops to appear on a poisonous surface; the dew drops from the first moment of their existence are poisoned; but that is not the fault of the atmosphere; it is the fault of him who strewed the poison. God decreed from all eternity to create human souls; He did not revoke that decree, but, foreknowing that the soul of each of us would be stained by the flesh of Adam, He formed the supplementary decree to repair the evil through the grace of the Redemption. It is better for man, says St. Thomas, "to be born with an infected nature than to be non-existent, chiefly because, through the grace of Christ, he can escape damnation."



### A NOTE TO NEWCOMERS

WELCOME TO THE TRADITIONAL LATIN MASS, and to the unchanged Catholic Faith. The priests and parishioners of Most Holy Trinity Seminary reject the changes of Vatican II. They want to preserve the Roman Catholic Faith by maintaining everything which was taught and done by the Church prior to Vatican II. In order to receive the sacraments here, it is therefore necessary that you attend exclusively the traditional Latin Mass, and avoid the New Mass, the reformed sacraments, as well as any Masses which are offered in union with the Vatican II hierarchy. We also invite you to take our booklet entitled *The Traditional Latin Mass*, which is very informative.

### DRESS CODE

**For men:** Jacket and tie on **Sundays and holydays of obligation**. No earrings. No shorts. **For ladies:** A dress or skirt is required; no pants or shorts. The skirt must at least cover the knee, and should not be tight or otherwise revealing in any way. Immodest slits are forbidden. **Clothing should be loose and not form-fitting.** A head covering is also required. See-through blouses are forbidden, as well as clothing which is low-cut either in front or in back. **For everyone:** No **tennis shoes, sandals, clogs, thongs**, denim, even on weekdays. No piercings. Clothing with writing on it (e.g., sweatshirts or jackets) is also forbidden. The standards of Catholic modesty must be observed. **Anyone in tight, provocative, or otherwise revealing attire will not be permitted to enter the church.**
